

Constitution of Man

Preamble

Mans' value has been harvested and plundered by monarchies, military rulers, dictators, lawmakers, fascist, socialist, democratic, and communist regimes, tyrants, and corrupt corporations. Suffering endless tyranny, and rule for centuries, none have fully allowed the sustaining of life according to free-will choice inherent within the nature of Man, qua Man, or unalienable right to life, equally bestowed by Creator upon every Living (Homo sapiens) Being without exception. Nevertheless endowed, Independent Living Beings of planet earth now seek life, freedom, and pursuit of happiness within their unalienable natural rights, equally drawn about by the rights of all others; all authority and usurpation refused. All Independent Living Beings may fulfil their purpose, according to their choice, all initiation of force, fraud or coercion by any Independent Living Being, or group forbidden; arresting force used for its cessation being lawful. To establish individual freedom, equality, and justice in perpetuity, We, the One People of Planet Earth, here ordain and establish this *Constitution of Man* equally of, and applicable to all Independent Living (human) Beings in posterity, and perpetuity.

Article 1`

Declaration of Individual Rights For every Living Human Being

1.1 Right to Life

- 1.1.1 Man's right to his own life is a self-evident truth.
- 1.1.2 Man's right to his own life is of nature, and by nature; natural rights being self-evident truth.
- 1.1.3 Natural Rights, are Unalienable Rights, belonging equally to every (human) Individual Living Being.

1.1.4 Unalienable Individual Rights, are indivisible further, impossible collectively.

1.1.5 Natural, Unalienable Rights of Independent Living Being's are endowed by Creator, immutable, inviolable; neither given, taken or transferable.

1.2 Right of Equality and Sovereignty

1.2.1 All Independent Living Being's, are created equal by their Creator, by which nature of being Man, qua Man, possess equally and unequivocally, Unalienable Right to Life, permitting no trespass.

1.2.2 By the Unalienable Right to Life endowed by Creator, all men are equally and independently sovereign according to the equal nature of being Man, qua Man.

1.2.3 No form of eminent domain shall henceforth exist.

1.2.4 No Independent Living Being, or aggregate of Independent Living Being's, shall annul, invalidate, or usurp the unalienable rights of another. No religious claim of right may negate, or usurp the unalienable rights of any Independent Living Being.

1.2.5 No Independent Living Being, or group of Independent Living Beings, shall be legally or otherwise deemed, classified, or treated as animal.

1.2.6 Independent Rights of Man, preside over all other life forms.

1.3 Right to Liberty

1.3.1 Life, Freedom, and the Pursuit of Happiness, are the Unalienable Right(s) of every Independent Living Being.

1.3.2 Free-will choice of thought, and action by any and all Independent Living Being's, are guaranteed inclusive of the responsibility, liability, and accountability, naturally and inherently flowing therefrom.

1.3.3 No Living Being severally, or Independent Living Being's collectively, may initiate force, coercion, blackmail, or fraud against any Independent Living Being's self, or property.

1.4 Right to Value and Property

1.4.1 Unalienable rights, immutably inherent in the natural essence of Man are: They cannot form, or be the object of a transaction, or contractual agreement, whether voluntary, or involuntary.

- 1.4.2 Individual property rights, derive from every Independent Living Being's Unalienable Right to action; from which action, material property is cultivated, made, or earned.
- 1.4.3 Any Independent Living Being's lawful action, that removes from the state of nature, and that blends his or her labour with material matter, to his or her enhancement of life, over that which has no owner, constitutes his or her inalienable right to the product/property thereby cultivated, made, or earned.
- 1.4.4 Property exchange transfers rights over things, but it does not create the right.
- 1.4.5 Unalienable Rights, are fully preserved in any process to contract for the acquisition, transfer, or exchange of property.
- 1.4.6 Each Independent Living Being, has the right to own personal property, free and clear of all encumbrances: No right to alienate property rights over things, entails the right to alienate the right itself, property rights thus preserved.
- 1.4.7 Value resulting from each and every Independent Living Being's thought, speech, and action to cultivate, make, earn or exchange property, is guaranteed 'Property' of said individual, regardless of thought, deed, or value manifestation; including each Independent Living Being's free will choice to gift, trade, or dispose of said value or property.
- 1.4.8 No redistribution of wealth, using legislative assemblies or any such-like institution, shall ever exist unless by/for the reparation of crimes committed against another.
- 1.4.9 Property, being that which can be gifted, bought, or sold is alienable, but the acquisition of property ownership by any other means, violates clause 1.4.6 of this Constitution.

1.5 Right of abdication

- 1.5.1 By the nature of Man, qua Man, whosoever violates, denies, or abrogates the rights of another, does by that action, abdicate the free-will right to so choose.
- 1.5.2 Save to protect the life of another Independent Living Being, initiation of force against another, constitutes the wilful surrender of self-rights for that duration, for which no mitigating circumstance may prevail.
- 1.5.3 Every Independent Living Being, has the Unalienable Right to dispose fully and freely of one's own body (life), of one's own faculties, of the fruits of one's labours, in non-violation of the rights of others.

1.6 Right of Independence

- 1.6.1 Any living being attaining the age of fifteen (15) years may until age eighteen years, subject to clause 1.6.3 choose to accept, hold and honour a “Probationary Acceptance (of) Sovereignty Status”, (hereafter PASS), such PASS redundant attaining age eighteen years.
- 1.6.2 PASS holders, choose by this means to accept the *Age of Independence*, and abiding by their sovereignty, to fully uphold the *Declaration of Individual Rights*, the *Constitution of Man*, with full responsibility, and accountability for their actions thereafter.
- 1.6.3 Any PASS holder, found to have transgressed their rights, and to have violated the *Declaration of Individual Rights*, and or this *Constitution of Man*, shall be held fully accountable for their actions as though adult, and by prior agreement in accepting a PASS, forfeit adult sovereign status until attaining the age of eighteen years.
- 1.6.4 Any PASS holder who, having held a PASS for twenty-four months without violation, or abrogation of another’s rights, may claim full adult sovereignty, though aged less than eighteen years.

1.7 Right of Protection

- 1.7.1 Retaliatory force may lawfully and morally be used, by any living being separately, or Independent Living Beings collectively, only in defence against those who violate Clauses 1.1 through 1.4 inclusive herein;
- 1.7.2 Physical retaliatory force, is lawfully limited to that necessary to arrest, or cause force initiated against Independent Living Being’s self, or property, to cease. (Refer to Article 4)

1.8 Rights in Perpetuity

- 1.8.1 By the right to life, in-bodied by all Independent Living Being’s, including value derived therefrom, no living being separately, or Individuals collectively, shall abrogate, subjugate, subordinate, fraudulently acquire, usurp, blackmail, invade, violate, commandeer, steal, arrest, confiscate, or detain the duly secured value of life, or property by principle of Natural Law, of any Independent Living Being’s domicile, without prejudice by creation, on earth.

1.9 Exceptions

- 1.9.1 No exception shall ever exist, or amendment be made to Clauses 1 through 7 herein, inclusive.

Article 2: Group Rights

2.1 Group Rights

- 2.1.1 No rights are ascribed, or conferred to 'collective' bodies; aggregate numbers of Individual Living Beings, regardless of howsoever claimed.
- 2.1.2 Conglomerate (whole) sums of Individual Living Beings can have no rights, they do not as Individual Living Beings already possess.
- 2.1.3 Human rights, indigenous rights, fundamental rights, workers rights, or other such claimed 'collective rights,' are obsolete; redundant.

Article 3: Previous laws

3.1 Previous laws Null and Void

- 3.1.1 This *Constitution of Man*, for any state or country that adopts it, henceforth supersedes, overrides, and makes null and void all current laws, positive law, regulations, directives, statutes, executive orders, that now or in the past, conflict with any part of this *Constitution of Man* in that State, Country, or Jurisdiction, regardless of previous or current authority, save laws of the Creator, and Natural Law.
- 3.1.2 This *Constitution of Man*, offered as Global and Universal Republic, by express *Declaration of Individual Rights* inherent in man, qua man, under the rule of Natural Law, expressly denies all forms of tyrannical rule howsoever quantified, or constructed, including that known as 'Democracy'.
- 3.1.3 No form of 'legal fiction,' or legal 'personification' pertaining to any Individual Living Being, howsoever named, described, or legislated shall henceforth exist.

Article 4: Protection

4.1 Commission for One People's Protection

- 4.1.1 By the *Declaration of Individual Rights*, independence, and freedom thus established, the aggregate sum of Individual Living Beings that are 'One People,' now seek unto themselves an elected body commissioned to protect every Individual Living Being's Right to Life, as set out in this *Constitution of Man*. Wherefrom is secured, and guaranteed, rightful freedom to unobstructed action according to One's will, within limits drawn around each by the equal unalienable rights of all other Independent Living Beings
- 4.1.2 This elected body, including all branches, shall be known as the *Commission of Justice*, its purpose to equally uphold and protect sovereign, unalienable, individual rights of all members of society, for orderly, universal, peaceful, harmonious co-existence of human life.
- 4.1.3 This *Commission of Justice*, including all branches chartered as *Regional Commissions of Justice* shall each have jurisdiction, in and over a land mass, which area is agreed by the *One People*, (hereafter jurisdiction).
- 4.1.4 These various societies, shall share common jurisdiction overlap, so to protect Individual Rights fluidly and equally, in common, as though one homogenous jurisdiction, regardless of culture, race, ethnicity, beliefs, or island, country, continent, hemisphere, or planet; *One People*.
- 4.1.5 Each separate *Regional Commission of Justice*, is fully bound by this *Constitution of Man* to conform to the 'Charter' for the *Regional Commission of Justice*.
- 4.1.6 By this *Constitution of Man*, each separate *Regional Commission of Justice*, is expressly forbidden any alternative intent, or control in any jurisdiction, including but not limited to any law, rule, regulation, statute, directive, or executive order, for so long as Man is Man (in perpetuity). Neither is permitted any construct, amendment, alteration, addition, abuse, or misuse of words in this document that might or would violate any article of this *Constitution of Man*.
- 4.1.7 No *Independent Commission of Justice* may offer or provide protection as described in the *Charter* for the *Regional Commission of Justice*, in or by any corporation, commercial, or business manner.

Article 5: Commission of Justice

5.1 Grant of Charter: Independent Commission of Justice

5.1.1 This *Constitution of Man*, hereby issues a *Grant of Charter* for the establishment and maintenance of an *Individual Commission of Justice*, whose purpose and function is to uphold this *Constitution of Man* in accordance with Creator's Natural Laws.

5.1.2 By this Grant of Charter all *Independent Commissions of Justice's* so established shall—

- a) uphold the *Declaration of Individual Rights*, as specified in Article 1 of this *Constitution of Man*;
- b) do that necessary to preserve Individual Rights as specified in Article 1 of this *Constitution of Man* through sub-structures of the Independent Commissions of Justice known as *Police Commission*, *Judiciary Commission*, and *Support Commission*.

Article 6: Amendments

6.1 Amendments to this Constitution of Man

6.1.1 No Article, or Section thereof, of this *Constitution of Man*, shall ever be repealed, or abrogated, in whole or in part.
